In Memoriam: Marie Saeli 1955 - 2023

Marie Saeli, a life-long Franklin Park resident, started working at the Library briefly in the late 1970s, then returned in 1990. She assisted in three departments concurrently: Circulation, Technical Services, and Business Office. Marie became Business Manager in 1997 and remained so until 2003, when the Executive Director vacancy arose. While working as director, she attended graduate school part-time to earn her library science degree. Over almost two decades, she oversaw the Library as it changed and evolved due to technology.

Marie attended North and Main schools, and she was a graduate of East Leyden High School, University of Illinois - Champaign (B.A in English), Northwestern University (Master's - Cinema Studies), and Dominican University (Master's in Library Science).

She was known for her love of animals, classic films, music, gardening, coffee and chocolate. She enjoyed teaching part-time as an adjunct instructor at Triton College. Marie was a past-president of the Franklin Park Woman's Club, and a long-time member. Rescuing strays was another pastime; many kittens she rescued were adopted by library staff. She will be missed.
